### CDC Guidelines to Help Prevent the Spread of COVID-19

- We encourage all staff, patrons, and swimmers to wash their hands often and cover their coughs and sneezes.
- We encourage the use of cloth face coverings as feasible. Face coverings are <u>most</u> essential in times when physical distancing is difficult.
- Face coverings are not to be worn in the pool at anytime, but recommended, not required when out of the pool
- We encourage staff, patrons, and swimmers to stay home (for example, if they have symptoms of COVID-19, have tested positive for COVID-19, or were exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 14 days) and when they can safely end their home isolation.
- Ensuring adequate supplies to support healthy hygiene.
  Supplies include soap, hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol (for staff and older children who can safely use hand sanitizer), paper towels, tissues, and no-touch trash cans.
- We encourage all patrons to remain socially distant from one another when sunbathing or during adult breaks.
