the Cleanliness Changes

- We are following the CDC guidelines for cleaning, disinfectants and sanitizers to address bacteria, virus, fungi and mold
- We are using EPA Registered Disinfectants
- We have increased the frequency of cleaning high touch areas
- More alcohol based hand sanitizer dispensers have been placed throughout our facilities
- Professional grade disinfectants are applied throughout our entire childcare and facilities after our deep cleaning is completed when our sites are closed
- The use of PPE (Gloves, masks, glasses) is to ensure the safety of our staff and possible transmission of any diseases
- All HVAC filters will be replaced prior to opening
- The processes to clean all exercise equipment after each use have been instituted
